 Biographical History: Robert Franks was one of the original founders of the NAWCC and its first president. He later became the Association's third editor. He died on December 22, 1975.

Content & Structure

• Scope & Content: This collection primarily consists of Franks' correspondence regarding various subjects in the watch and clock industry with approximately half of the folders dedicated to the specific affairs of the NAWCC: budget, costs, conventions, chapters, etc. Franks also conducted historical research on subjects such as watchmakers from various cities: Baltimore, MD; Philadelphia, PA; Bradford, MA, etc.
