Biographical Sketch

• **Biographical History**: Brooks Palmer was the president of the National Association of Watch and Clock Collectors from 1951-1953. He authored The Book of American Clocks and A Treasury of American Clocks, two heavily quoted resources of information in the industry. He died on January 9, 1974 at the age of 73.

Content & Structure

Scope & Content: This collection primarily consists of Palmer's correspondence
regarding various subjects in the watch and clock industry; including two large folders of
correspondence about an article of his, "Your Clock May Be an Antique", published in
March, 1946. Also in the collection are: photographs and drawings of a number of
clocks and watches, documentation regarding National Association of Watch and Clock
Collectors (NAWCC) events, drafts of his articles, newspaper articles about industry
subjects, his personal notes and items (travel brochures, articles from childhood,
deposit slips, etc.)
