- **Scope & Content:** This collection includes documents collected by Frederick M. Selchow, who was based in New Hampshire. This includes photographs and information of clockmakers such as Levi Hutchins, Simon Willard, and the Blasdel family of clockmakers. Additionally, this collection includes correspondence,

newspaper clippings, auction records, etchings, and plans of a movement by an unidentified maker.
